This report contains a review of the Agency's technical co-operation activities in Cyprus carried out during 1984 - 1994. In terms of coverage and analytical depth, country programme summaries stand somewhere midway between in-depth country programme evaluations and individual project evaluations. They attempt to provide a comprehensive, descriptive picture of the Agency's co-operation with a Member State in a manner that will be particularly useful for programming decisions. The attempt is very much to describe -- largely through statistical data -- not to provide independent analysis and evaluation.

INTRODUCTION

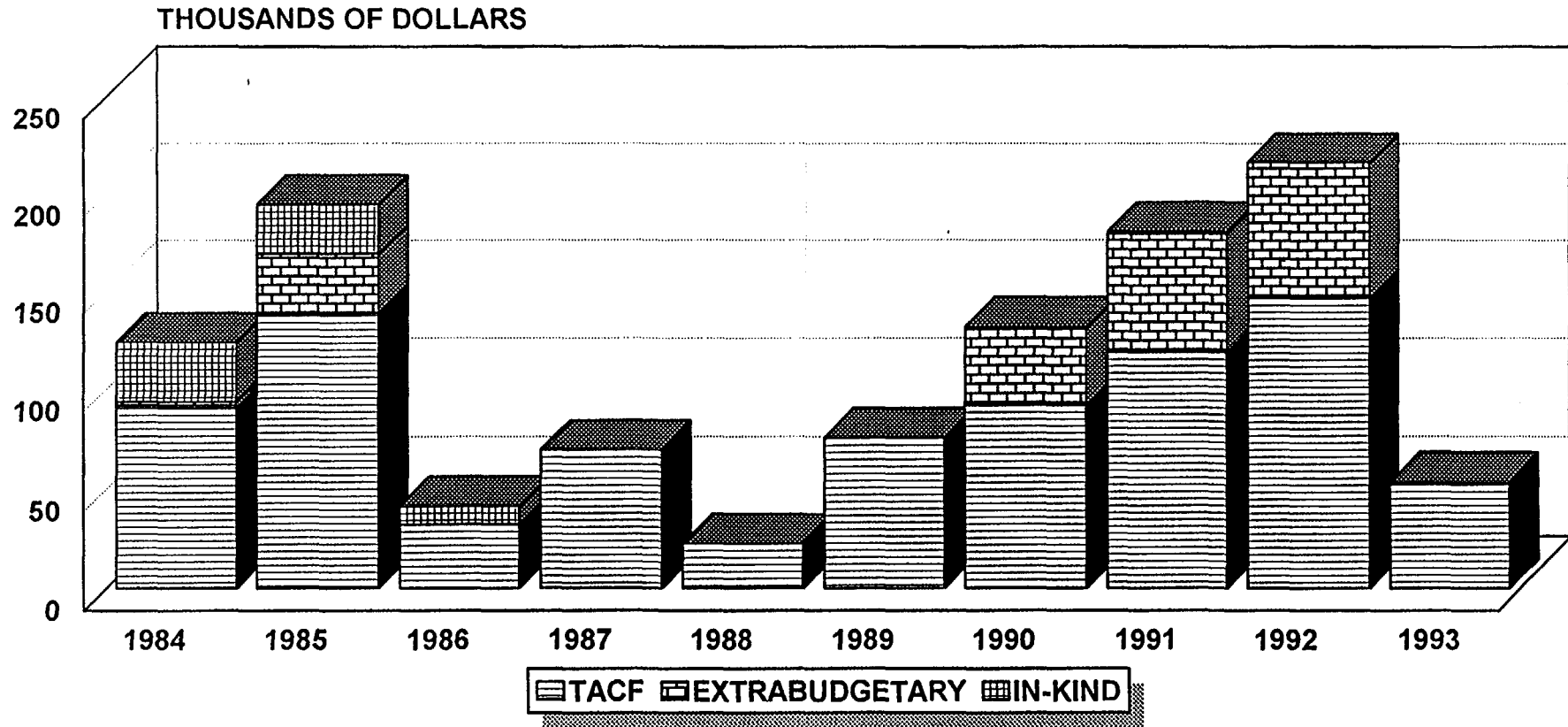
The country programme summary reported on here is one in the series of such studies being undertaken of the Agency's TC programme with Member States. With over \$1.6 million of Agency support received, Cyprus ranks 67th among all recipients of technical assistance during the period 1958 through 1993.

By far the largest portion of the assistance received over the past ten years has been provided in the form of equipment (72%), complemented to almost equal parts by training (15%) and expert services (13%). Three quarters of the resources was made available through the TACF (75%), the rest was provided through extrabudgetary contributions (19%) and assistance in kind (6%).

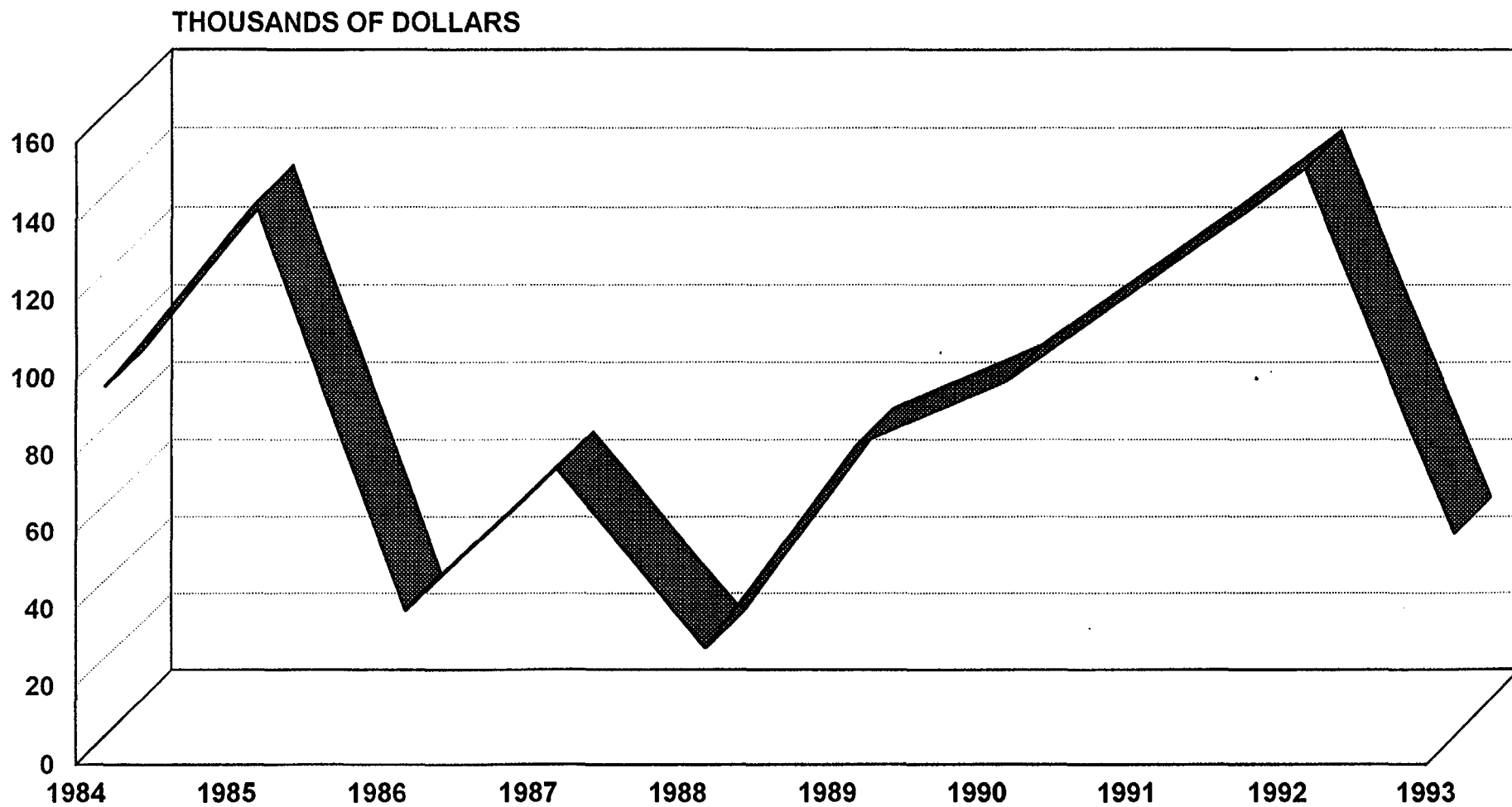
As regards the distribution, by sector, of disbursements under those projects that are operational or were completed during the period 1984 through the end of September 1994, the three major areas were agriculture (50%), nuclear safety (22%) and industry and hydrology (20%). Only very small shares went to nuclear physics and chemistry (5%) and nuclear medicine (3%).

Since 1984, scientists from Cyprus have completed 15 assignments as Agency experts and training course lecturers or as participants in research co-ordination meetings. During the same period, Cyprus has hosted two fellowships and two regional group training events for a total of 24 participants.

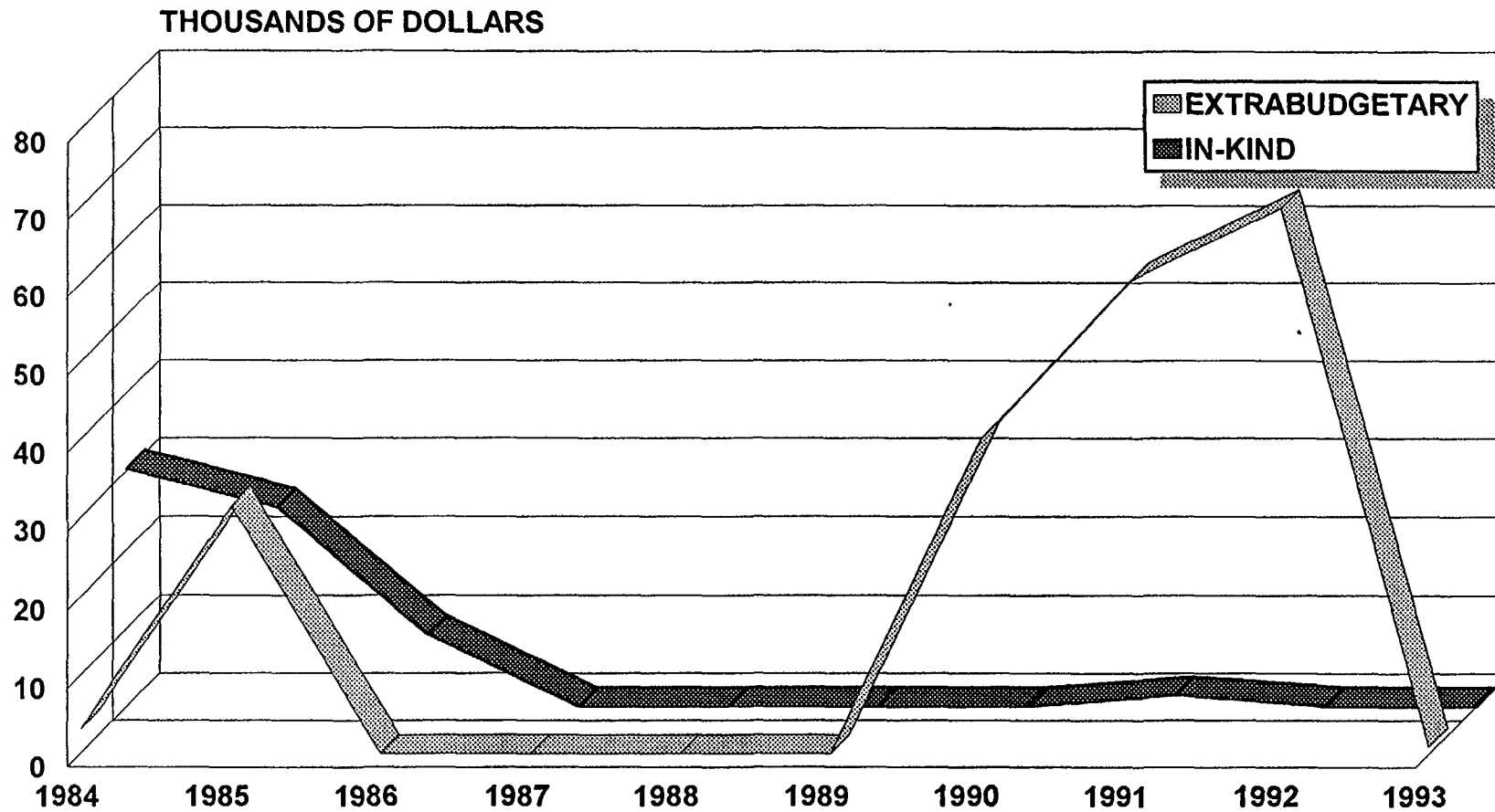
ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE AGENCY TO CYPRUS BY SOURCE (1984 - 1993)



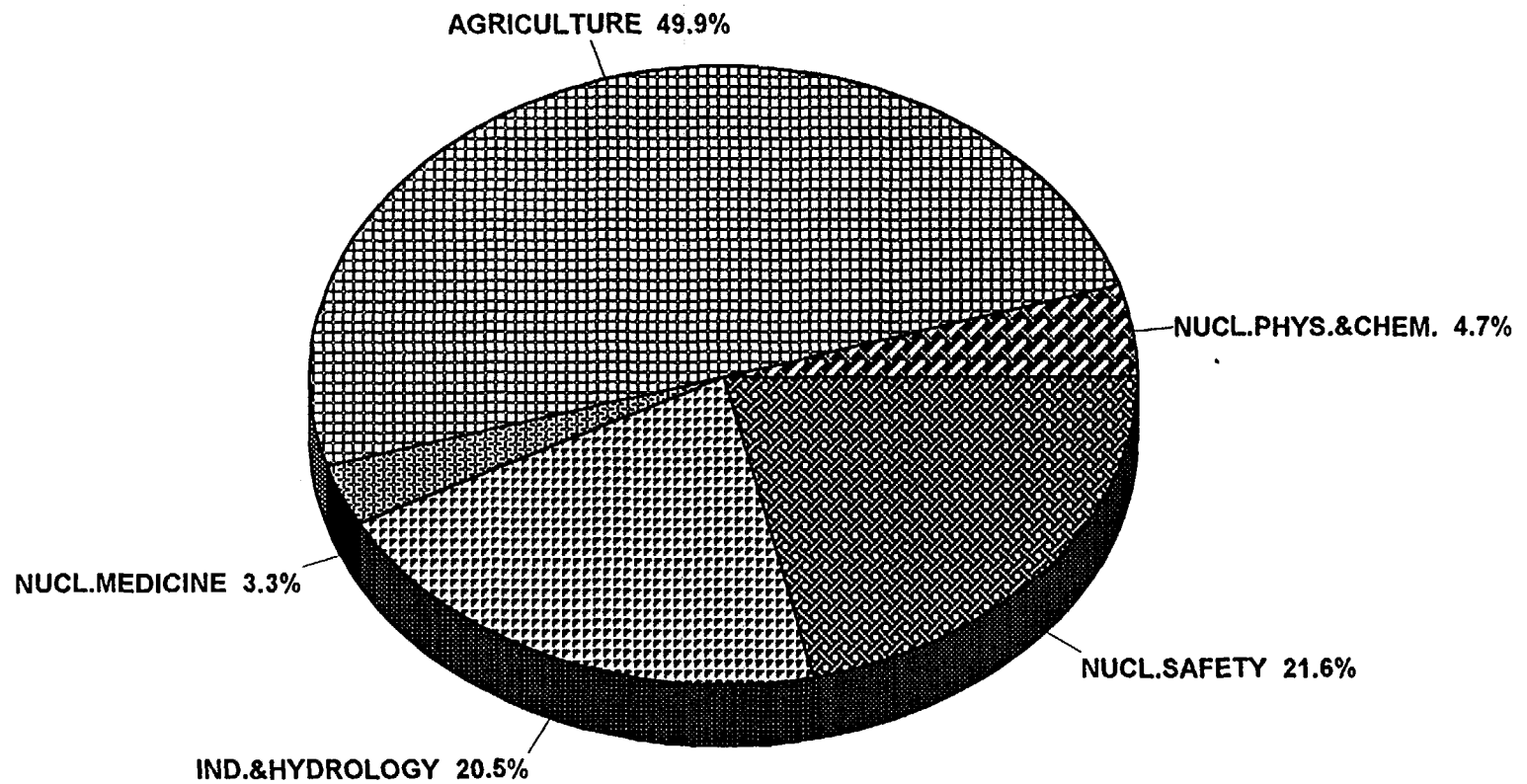
TACF ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO CYPRUS (1984 - 1993)



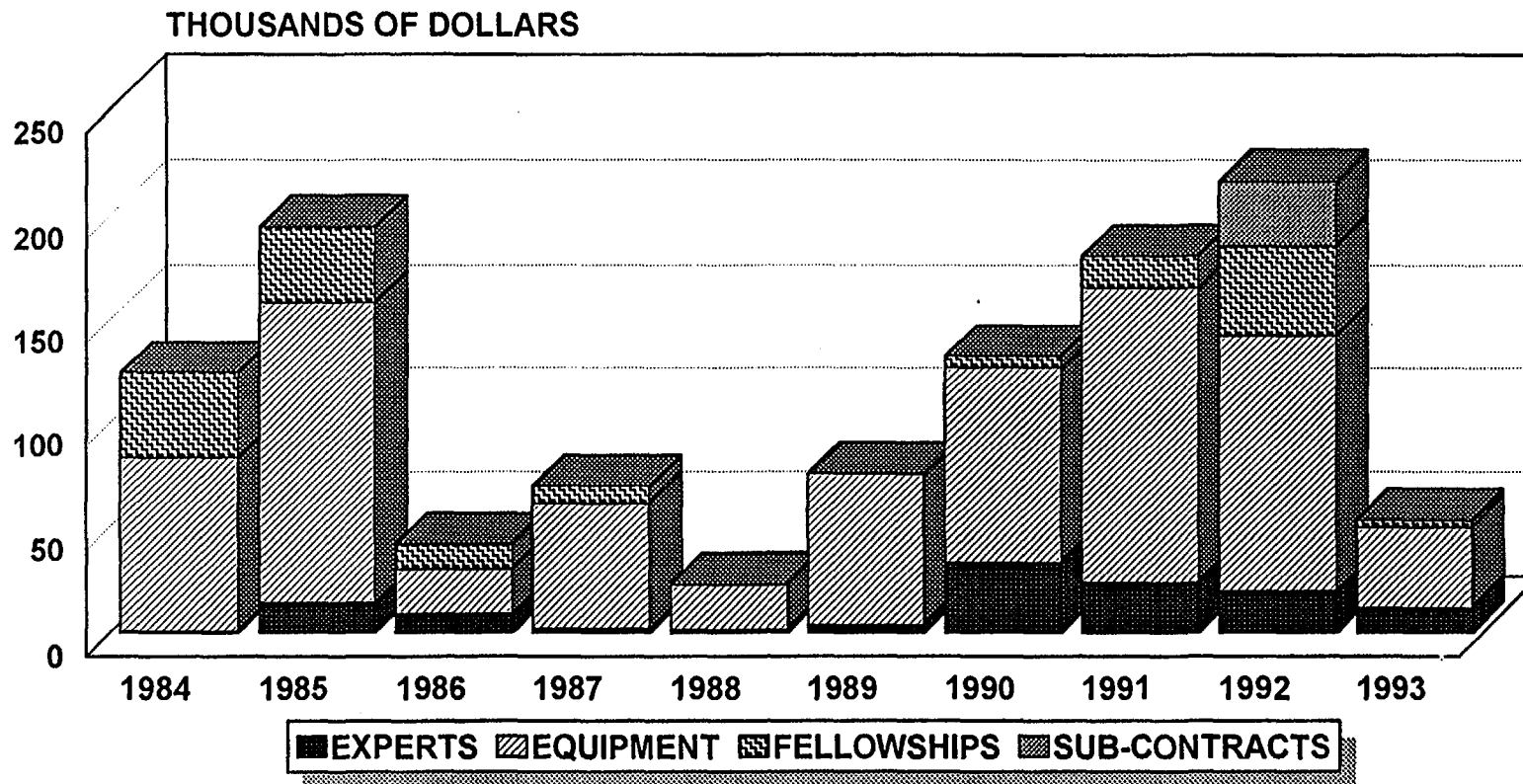
EXTRABUDGETARY AND IN-KIND ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO CYPRUS (1984 - 1993)



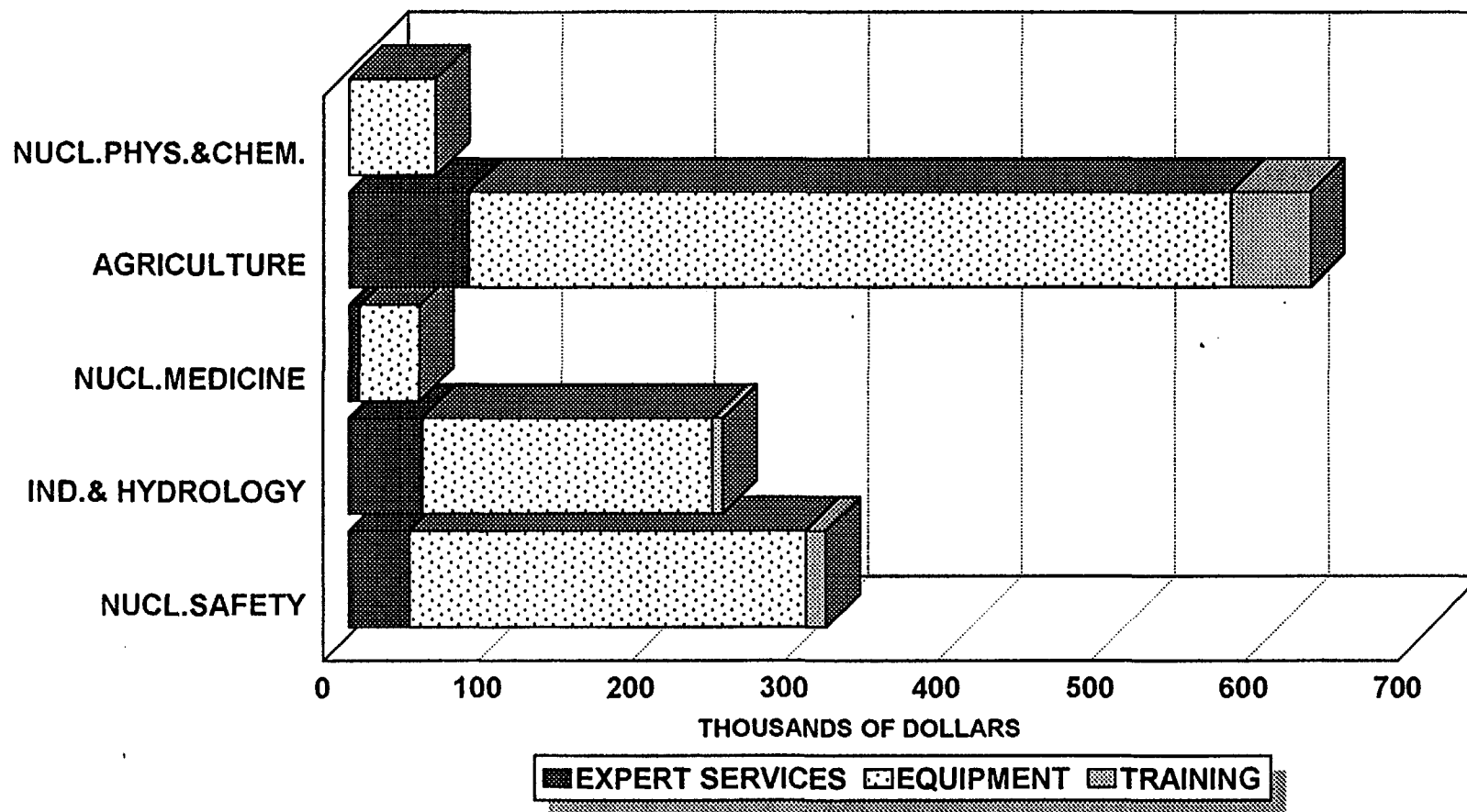
TC PROJECT DISBURSEMENTS IN CYPRUS BY SECTOR (1984 - 1994)
