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HANFORD TANKS INITIATIVE QUALITY ASSURANCE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

1.0 SCOPE

Hanford Tanks Initiative (HTI) is a five-year activity resulting from the technical and financial partnership of the U. S. Department of Energy's Office of Waste Management (EM-30), and Office of Science and Technology Development (EM-50). HTI will develop and demonstrate technologies and processes for characterization and retrieval of single shell tank waste. Activities and products associated with HTI consist of engineering, construction, procurement, closure, retrieval, characterization, and safety and licensing.

HTI Quality Assurance Implementation Plan for Nuclear Facilities defines the controls for the products and activities developed by HTI. Project Hanford Management Contract (PHMC) Quality Assurance Program Description (QAPD) (HNF-PRO-599) is the document that defines the quality requirements for Nuclear Facilities. The QAPD provides direction for compliance to 10 CFR 830.120 "Nuclear Safety Management, Quality Assurance Requirements."

2.0 ORGANIZATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

HTI PROJECT MANAGER has overall responsibility for compliance to the QAPD for all HTI activities and products. He has directed the HTI Team that compliance to QAPD for all HTI activities and products is mandatory.

C-106 DEMONSTRATION LEAD has overall responsibility for the development of technology in the removal of C-106 heel. This includes upgrading the C-106 infrastructure, interfaces with the vendors' technology, vendors' technology development and heel removal.

SYSTEM ENGINEERING has overall responsibility to implement some disciplined systems engineering approach to each of the HTI Projects (retrieval demonstration, characterization and tank closure) as defined in the TWRS System Engineering Management Plan (SEMP) and using a graded approach appropriate for a development and demonstration project.

SAFETY, PERMITTING AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT is responsible for identifying the need for safety and permitting documentation and permits that may be required. Also entailed is planning and obtaining funds and resources to prepare the needed documents, as well as obtaining the required approvals. Additional responsibilities include management of public involvement task package and ensuring adequate support for HTI.

CHARACTERIZATION LEAD has the overall responsibility for the planning and implementation of those activities required to measure the radionuclide and hazardous chemical inventory, through sampling and analysis of residual waste that remains at the AX-104 tank site. This includes developing sampling and analysis plans and deployment of technology to measure the volume and concentrations of contaminants of concern that remain both in the tank and that may have leaked into the surrounding backfill and vadose zone. This effort supports the Retrieval Performance Evaluation Criteria Assessment for development of retrieval and tank closure alternatives.

TANK CLOSURE BASIS LEAD has the overall responsibility for the management, planning, implementation, and oversight of those activities required for assessment of retrieval performance evaluation criteria alternatives for the AX Farm. This includes management, coordination and performance of those activities required for conducting studies to provide essential engineering data for input to the retrieval performance evaluation criteria alternatives assessment of short and long-term risk and cost; development of preliminary tank closure concepts based on viable technical approaches, identification of the work-related tasks and activities, and development of associated estimates of worker doses, worker hours, and cost; performing technical and administrative liaison with providers of engineering services and the DOE contractor responsible for performing the retrieval performance evaluation criterion's alternative's assessment; and technical oversight and interface of HTI Project closure-related activities.

QUALITY ASSURANCE has overall responsibility to provide a level of assurance that HTI products and activities are performed in accordance with client requirements. Quality Engineering responsibilities on project work is coordinated with HTI Project Manager.

HTI PERSONNEL are responsible for performing work in accordance with the requirements set forth in the established Project Hanford Policies and Procedures (PHPP). The PHPPs are the controls necessary to comply with those QAPD requirements.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

HTI LEADS will assure that all personnel performing work in their area of responsibility understand compliance to the PHPP is mandatory.

HTI Personnel are responsible for identifying problems related to quality and reporting them to the appropriate level of HTI Management.

The quality requirements imposed by the QAPD are applicable to all HTI products and activities, and will be performed using graded approach in accordance with Part 2, Section 1, Paragraph 3.9 of the QAPD.

No additional quality requirements, other than those defined in the QAPD, will be used to implement project (HTI) work.

Attachment 1, "QAPD IMPLEMENTATION MATRIX" reflects the site-wide Project Hanford Procedures. Site-wide procedures are under the control of Fluor Daniel Hanford, Inc. (FDH) and are identified in the Project Hanford Policies and Procedure System. The PHPP system will be used by all HTI personnel when working on an HTI product or activity. The Matrix is for information only.

Attachment 2, "TYPES OF VERIFICATION AND INSPECTIONS" reflects the types of verification and inspections to be performed for overall compliance to the design.
