**ON THE TRANSFORMATION OF SYNCOPES AND SYNCOPAL CRISES TOWARDS
EPILEPSY CONVULSIVELESS FORMS**

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The clinical analysis of consciousness disorders in the liquidators of the Chernobyl accident aftereffects, testify to a growth of pathological changes in brain vessels with pronounced polymorphism of paroxysmal vegetative disorders. The paroxysmal consciousness disorders may appear at the hemodynamics disturbances, mainly in the vertebro-basilar basin and in the structure of hypothalamic syndromes. The dynamics of loading of vascular disorders and change of accompanying syncopal states in the part of patients allows to speak about their transformation into the convulsiveless forms of epilepsy in the form of partial, generalized and mixed paroxysms. At partial paroxysms the dysmnestic states, the epileptic vertigo and the trance consciousness disorders prevail. The generalized paroxysms proceed in the form of simple, complicated and vegetative absence. In the neurological symptomatology of the above patients the organic neurological disorders prevail, the electroencephalographic examinations appear by change in bioelectric activity of brain structures in the form of hypersynchronization and disorganization of rhythms. At Echo-EG a displacement of the middle echo and an enlargement of ventricular brain system is observed in the distinct degree of expressing. The psychological examinations fix the breach of mnestic activity and the change of personality. The observation of the development of processes during three years allow to affirm, on the grounds of the clinical data and the results of paraclinical examinations, about the transformation of syncopal states into the different forms of convulsiveless epilepsy.
