OVERVIEW:

The Energy Efficiency Center (EEC) activities have been concentrated on Energy Efficiency Network (SEGE), education and training of energy auditors.

EEC has started studies related to renewable fuels (biofuel, wastes) and other topics related to environment protection. EEC has continued close collaboration with Institute for Energy Technology, Kjeller, Norway.

It has been organized and conducted Seminar and Workshop on "How to Reduce Energy and Water Cost in Higher Education Buildings" for general and technical managers of the higher education institutions. This Seminar was preceded by the working meeting on energy efficiency strategy in higher education at the Ministry of National Education.

EEC has worked out proposal for activities of Cracow Regional Agency for Energy Efficiency and Environment and has made offer to provide services for this Agency in the field of training, education and consulting.

The vast knowledge and experiences in the field of energy audits have been used by the members of EEC in lecturing at energy auditors courses authorized by the National Energy Efficiency Agency (KAPE). Altogether 20 lectures have been delivered.
