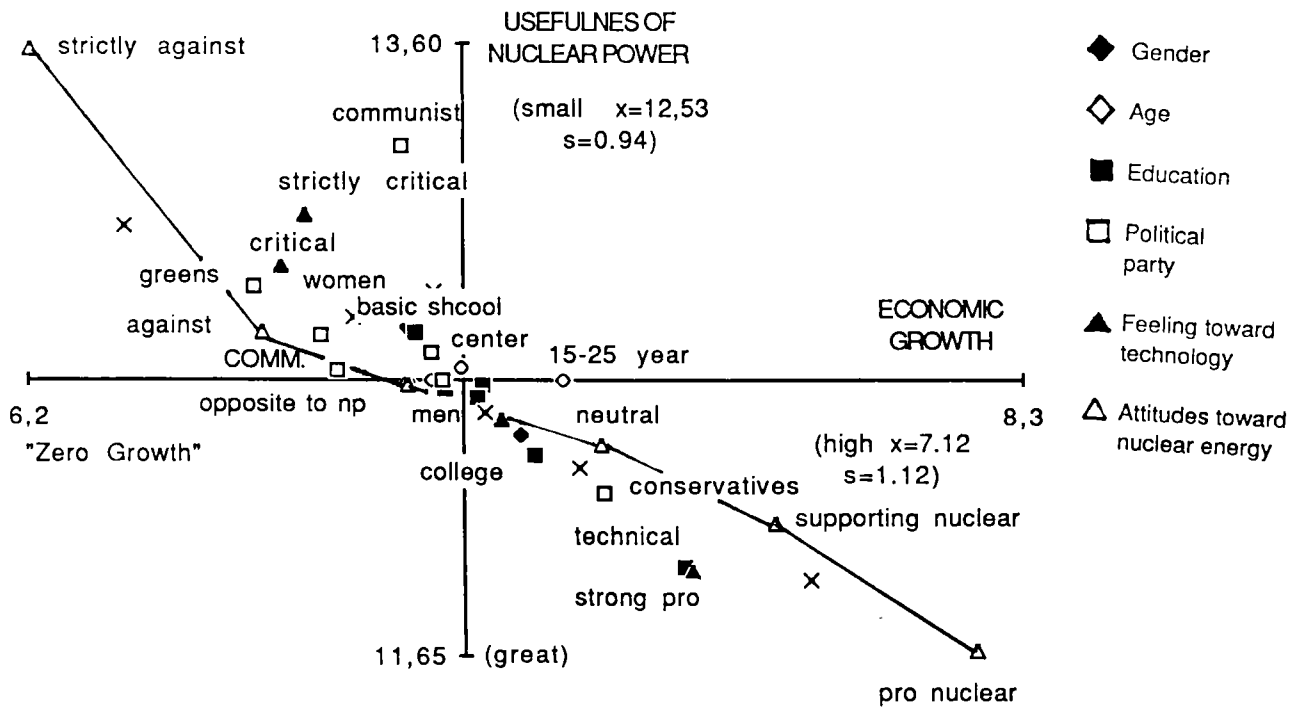

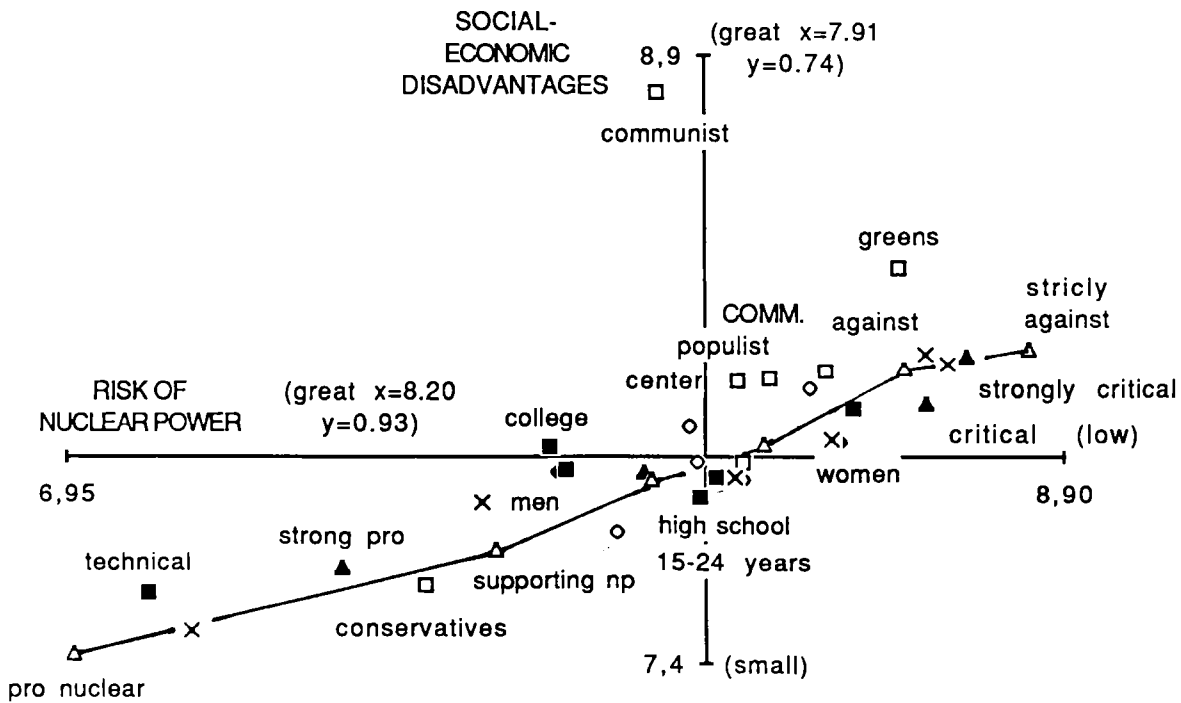

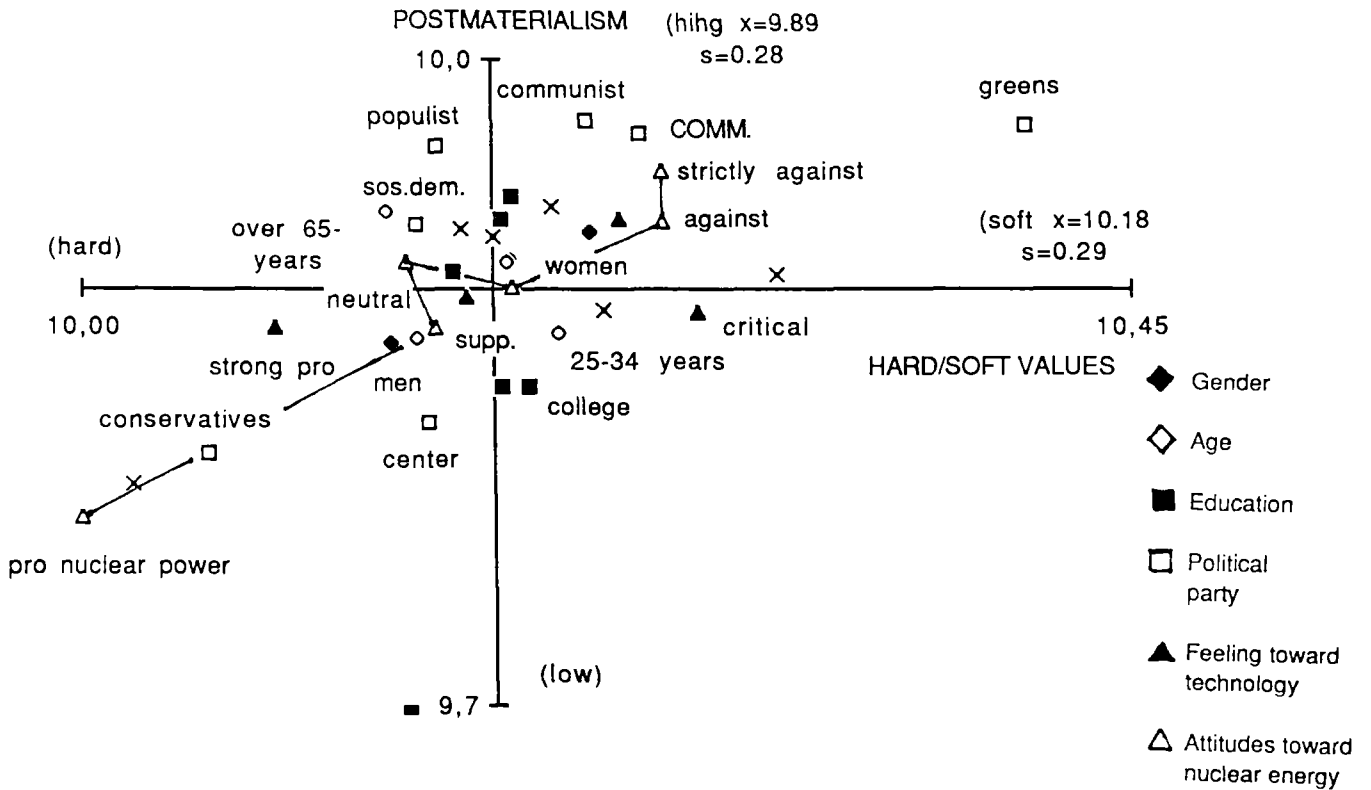
advantages of nuclear power (factorscores of different subgroups)
